

























	<p>Item # 2820 Name: Howden Pumpkin High yields of 15 to 25 lb pumpkins. Smooth skinned, tall in shape and easy to carve. 105 day direct seed. Packet contains at least 10 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2840 Name: Cinderella Pumpkin Pumpkin These magical coach shaped fruits can weigh from 20 to 25lbs. Excellent flavor in the deep orange flesh. Uniform. Heavily ribbed and flattened . 105 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 10 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2850 Name: Cherrybelle Radish Round, bright cherry red radish best used before 2" diameter. Good keeper that can be planted all summer long. 25 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2860 Name: French Breakfast Radish Mild and tasty. Bright scarlet red fading to icicle white tips. Medium green tops. Long tapered roots are best at about 3'. 25 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2862 Name: German Giant Radish Very large German variety. Scarlet red roots are crisp and pungent. Harvest from marble to baseball size. 29 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2870 Name: Pink Beauty Radish Rose-pink color. Round. Small taproot and unique pleasing flavor. Grows large without becoming pithy. 27 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2900 Name: Black Beauty Zucchini Squash Semi upright. Open plants for easier harvest. Blocky, very deep green fruits. Very early and productive. 70 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>

	<p>Item # 2908 Name: Early Prolific Straightneck Yellow Squash Uniform, Lemon Yellow fruits. Slightly warted and club-shaped. Firm, fine-grained flesh, great for grilling. 55 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2910 Name: Early Crookneck Yellow Squash Rich flavor and nice firm texture. Best when picked young at 5 to 6". Produces all season. 58 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2920 Name: Table Queen Bush Acorn Winter Squash Early 2 lb fruit has dark green, ribbed rind with orange flesh. Tolerates poor soils better than others. Vigorous and prolific. 75 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2940 Name: Waltham Butternut Winter Squash Semi bush variety that is very productive. 10 to 12" fruits are uniform and average 3 pounds. 80 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2945 Name: Spaghetti Winter Squash Vining winter squash with medium size egg shaped fruits that mature to a deep yellow. Bake or boil and fork out flesh for a vegetable spaghetti. 90 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2950 Name: Delicata Winter Squash 7" to 9" fruit is cream with dark green stripes. The rich orange flesh has a taste and texture similar to seet potato. Short prolific vines. 80 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2960 Name: Burgess Buttercup Winter Squash Flattened turbans 5" to 8" in diameter and 3 to 5 lb fruit. Very sweet medium orange flesh, stringless. Medium keeper. 90 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 2970 Name: Gardeners Delight Cherry Tomato Indeterminate. Very sweet red fruit borne in clusters. Plants need staking and plenty of room. One of the very best for tomato flavor. 68 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 50 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3010 Name: Red Pear Cherry Tomato Indeterminate. One of the oldest American Heirlooms. Excellent flavor and huge yields. 68 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 50 seeds</p>







	<p>Item # 3040 Name: Amish Paste Paste Tomato Indeterminate. Red color in a medium sized, ox-heart shape. Paste type with excellent flavor. 85 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3043 Name: Roma Paste Tomato Determinate. The standard paste tomato. Vines produce large yields of pear shaped, thick-walled and solid fruit. 68 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3047 Name: San Marzano Paste Tomato Indeterminate. Large vines with heavy leaf cover to protect fruit. Crack resistant fruits hold well on vines. Very high in tomato solids for canning. 75 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 50 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3050 Name: Brandywine Slicing Tomato Indeterminate. Old time tomato prized for it's incredible flavor. Potato leaved vines. Fruits average 8-16 ounces. 85 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3060 Name: Tigerella Slicing Tomato Indeterminate. Sometimes known as 'Mr. Stripey'. Reddish orange fruit with distinct striping. Great tangy flavor and surprisingly productive. 65 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3065 Name: Green Zebra Slicing Tomato Indeterminate. This tomato is ripe while still green. Will turn slightly yellow when dead ripe. Great color addition to salsas. 60 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3110 Name: Burbank Slicing Tomato Determinate. Medium sized round red fruit. Test very high in amino acids. Prefers drier conditions. 70 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3140 Name: Siletz Slicing Tomato Determinate. Early peak yield. Vigorous plants with good leaf coverage to protect fruit and gather the energy. Large fruit set well in cool weather. 62 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 40 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3170 Name: Sunray Slicing Tomato Indeterminate. Large yellow gold colored fruit. Low acidity with great flavor. Good disease resistance and large overall yields. 72 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 50 seeds</p>

	<p>Item # 3180 Name: Verde Tomatillo Husked fruit 2" to 3" in diameter. Ingredient in classic Mexican sauces. Sprawling plants will reseed. 65 days from transplant. Packet contains at least 100 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3185 Name: Purple Top Turnip Fast growing crisp turnip. Grows very large and remains tender. Best if harvested at baseball size or smaller. 55 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 1000 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3186 Name: Golden Globe Turnip Sweet golden yellow turnips with fine flavor similar to rutabaga. Plant spring or fall for tender roots. 55 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 1000 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3195 Name: Moon & Stars Watermelon Early. Round dark green fruit with with large yellow "moons" and smaller "stars". Sweet fruit matures quickly. 82 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 20 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 3205 Name: Crimson Sweet Watermelon Light green fruit with dark green stripes. Bright and deep red flesh has the classic sweet watermelon flavor. Up to 25 lbs. 88 days direct seed. Packet contains at least 25 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 5000 Name: Genovese Basil Ocimum basilicum. Annual. Tall, slow to bolt variety most often used for pestos. Large deep green leaves. Sweet fragrance. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 5001 Name: Cinnamon Basil Ocimum basilicum. Annual. Cinnamon scented plants. Plants display reddish purple stalks on a 2' bush. Sweet spicy flavor goes well with fruit. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 5010 Name: Lemon Basil Ocimum citriodorum. Annual. Lemony fragrance. Uses may include cooking with fish, teas, porpourris, dried arrangements. Light green leaves for contrast. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
	<p>Item # 5015 Name: Globe Basil Ocimum minimum. Annual. Also known as greek basil. Great for container growing. Very intense, sweet basil fragrance. Slow to go to seed. Packet contains at least 250 seeds</p>
